

How to Install and Use Echo360 Universal Capture: Personal

1. Log into your **Echo360 Account:**



2. Under the **Create** button, select **New Software Capture**.



- a. First time users will be redirected to the install website.
 Install Echo360 Universal Capture: Personal on your device.
- b. For current users tap the **New Software Capture** button to launch the Echo360 Universal Capture app on your device.
- c. You can also just launch the app by locating the Echo360 icon and launching your app.

Your items to record appear:

Webcam


Audio indicator

Desktop


Record Button

If not, you may need to adjust System permissions. Any permission questions prompts, just say yes to grant Echo360 access to the computer desktop, camera, mic, etc.

3. IMPORTANT - Tap Edit Capture Details in the top left corner.



The **Capture Details** form opens.



4. Fill out the form, enter the following:

Title – Enter a title for your course. Use a descriptive title so you can search for it easily. Consider including a date.

Description – Describe the content or topics in the video.

Tags – Great for searching by topic key words.

Publish to - Choose:

Library – The video will publish to a single library that holds all of your videos. (Formerly My Content)

Course/Section – The actual Echo360 Course and Section where the video is to be used. – **Recommended**

Class – New Class means a new video. Class = Video

Live Stream – Check this if you wish to have yourself, your students, and/or a TA watch live streaming of your recording.

Save – Tap **Save** to finish your set up. Do this for every recording.


5. Tap the Red Record Button.




6. Echo will count down, and the Echo dialog box will close. You are now recording. Bring up your PowerPoint show or other activities and present your content. You will see just your desktop.

Try to make shorter presentations, 10 to 15 minutes, topic by topic. Even if you are live streaming to students, they will get a green live link to each video you start and jump on for each topic. They will appreciate the shorter videos.


8. When finished, Find the small Echo360 icon and stop recording:







7. The video uploads automatically. Wait for video to finish processing:




Add Video/Presentation as a Class

You can add your video to a specific Echo Course Section – as a Class in your Echo/Canvas Course, by doing the following:







1. To add a video as a Class, when processing completes, hover over three dots in the bottom right corner blue hox Videographer/Video Editor

three dots in the bottom right corner blue box.


2. Select **Share** then **Class** tab (Class = one video).



3. Tap **New Class** Tab and Select: **Course, Term, Section**

(This is a new video not a replacement video, so **New Class**.)

- 4. Enter:
 Class Name
 Start Date
 Start Time
 Duration or length
- 5. Type a **Description**
- 6. Check **Availability/Settings**



7. Important: Tap **Share** button to save, and video now appears in your selected Course.
